The discussion will then move onto **monitoring the avian patient**, from vital parameters to capnography, doppler, electrocardiography, and pulse oximetry. Dr. Crosta will also discuss analgesia, intra-operative fluid therapy, and specific concerns related to avian anesthesia, such as positioning the patient, hypocalcemia, air sac cannulation, and as well as management of diving birds. This seminar will conclude with practical tips for safe and uneventful patient **recovery**.
