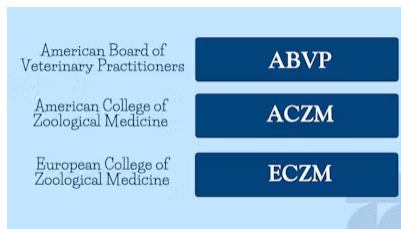

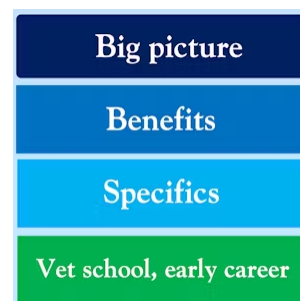
## Six amazing panelists shared their time and expertise
